

Chlamydiae

Transmission through unprotected vaginal and anal sex. **Contagion often remains unnoticed.** If a chlamydial infection is not treated, it often leads to an inflammation of the abdomen. This can lead to infertility.

Symptoms in women

- Increased discharge
- Irregular bleeding
- Pain in sexual intercourse

Protection

Condoms. Women should be regularly examined by the female doctor for chlamydia - you have to ask the doctor! Symptoms are often not noticed, but the consequences of an infection are serious!

Treatment

Antibiotics and rest; A follow-up examination is required. If possible, all sexual partners should be sent to the doctor to check for chlamydia!

Investigation of customers

Some men have discharge (clear or milky, different in color); Ask your customers if they feel pain or sting when urinating. Pay attention to swelling of the testicle or anus, redness on the urethral outlet.
