Checklist for EU citizens

What I need to work legally as a sex worker in Austria:

- ➤ Meldezettel: Within three days, I have to report my residence in Austria.
- \blacktriangleright Within one month I have to register myself at the tax office.
- Within one month I have to register myself at the Social Insurance Institution (SVA).
- Registration certificate (Anmeldebescheinigung): If I'm staying through three months in Austria I need to apply for a registration certificate.
- Every six weeks I have to be tested at the Health Department, so that my health card remains valid.
- > The counsellors of SXA-Info can inform me about everything. They can also help me with the forms and bureaucratic procedures.

What to do in the case of violence?

- > Nobody is allowed to force me into prostitution or sexual practices. Nobody is allowed to threaten me or my family, or use violence against me.
- ▶ Police Emergency: 133
